## **2.1 SUGGESTIONS**

1. First intervention: Action together with all PET groups in a striking way;

Period of action: During the week of the freshman;

Actions:

• Solid waste collection on a sectoral basis: Each PET Group is responsible for collecting solid waste, differentiating waste from waste dumps and residues found on the floor from Monday March 5th, all collected material will be stored until the day of "ACTION ";

• Mini lectures emphasizing the reason for the action, highlighting the importance of recycling and sustainability;

• Storage location: to be defined.
